

SENATE BILL No. 7

AN ACT concerning the state board of education; affecting the powers and duties thereof; amending K.S.A. 72-7513 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 72-7513 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-7513. In general, but not by way of limitation, consonant with other applicable statutory provisions, the state board of education shall:

(a) Adopt and maintain standards, criteria, guidelines or rules and regulations for the following:

(1) School libraries and other educational materials with the exception of textbooks;

(2) courses of study and curriculum;

(3) ~~Accredit~~ *accreditation* of schools including elementary, *and secondary and junior colleges, public and nonpublic;*

(4) certification of administrators, teachers, counselors, school nurses and supervisors of school districts and of the state department of education and of teachers and administrators of nonpublic schools; *and*

(b) administer the laws of this state concerning the matters named in this section and all other matters relating to ~~the~~ general supervision of the public schools and institutions under supervision of the state board of education.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 72-7513 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
