[As Amended by Senate Committee of the Whole] Session of 2001 SENATE BILL No. 89 By Committee on Elections and Local Government 1 - 22AN ACT concerning local units of government; relating to rent control. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. As used in this act, "local unit of government" means any political subdivision of this state, including but not limited to a county, municipality or township. Sec. 2. (a) No local unit of government shall enact, maintain or en-force any ordinance or resolution that would have the effect of controlling the amount of rent charged for leasing private residential or commercial property. (b) This section shall not impair the right of any local unit of govern-ment to manage and control residential property in which such local unit of government has a property interest. [(c) Except as required to comply with the Kansas offender reg-istration act, K.S.A. 22-4901 et seq., and amendments thereto, no local unit of government shall enact or enforce any law, ordinance, rule, regulation or resolution which requires any landlord to pro-vide to such local unit of government a list of names of any tenants of such landlord.] Sec. 3. Sections 1 and 2 shall be known as the Kansas anti-rent con-trol act. Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
