AN ACT relating to public officers; enacting the constitutional awareness

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the constitutional awareness act.

- Sec. 2. (a) On and after the effective date of this act, the office of the secretary of state shall provide [make available] to each candidate for state office and each person appointed to a state office a copy of each of the following documents:
 - (1) The constitution of the United States:
 - (2) The constitution of the state of Kansas;
- (3) the current examination for United States citizenship used by the immigration and naturalization service; and
- (4) the answer sheet or other listing of the correct answers for the document listed in paragraph (3).
- (b) As used in this section, "state office" means the office of governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state, attorney general, state treasurer, commissioner of insurance, state senator, state representative, member of the state board of education and any appointive office for which the appointment is subject to confirmation by the senate as provided in K.S.A. 75-4315b and amendments thereto.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
