AN ACT concerning the 1st Kansas (Colored) Voluntary Infantry regiment capitol mural; amending K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 75-2264 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 75-2264 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-2264. (a) The Kansas state historical society and the department of administration capitol restoration commission, established by the legislative coordinating council, shall develop plans to place a mural in the capitol honoring the 1st Kansas (Colored) Voluntary Infantry regiment. Such plans shall be developed in consultation with the joint committee on arts and cultural resources.

- (b) On or before January 1, 2002 2003, the plans developed pursuant to subsection (a) shall be submitted to the joint committee on arts and cultural resources.
 - Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 75-2264 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
