K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 75-4709 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 75-4709. (a) The secretary of administration shall provide for and 16 coordinate all telecommunications services for all divisions, departments 17and agencies of the state pursuant to policies established by the infor-18 mation technology executive council. The secretary of administration shall 19 have the authority to control the acquisition, retention and use of all 20 telecommunications services for all divisions, departments and agencies 21 of the state, and to develop and review plans and specifications for tele-22 communications services throughout the state. 23 (b) The secretary of administration, when feasible, may enter into 24agreements with any entity defined in this subsection extending to such 25entity the use of state intercity telecommunications facilities and services

As used in this subsection, an "entity" means:

under the control of the secretary.

(1) Any governmental unit, including any state agency, taxing subdi-vision of the state or municipality; or

(2) any hospital or nonprofit corporation, whether or not for profit,
which the secretary determines to be performing any state function on
an ongoing basis through *contract*, agreement or otherwise, or any function which will assist a governmental unit in attaining an objective or goal,
bearing a valid relationship to powers and functions of such unit.

35 Every record made, maintained or kept by the secretary of ad-(c) 36 ministration or the division of information systems and communications, 37 or any agency or instrumentality thereof, which relates to the acquisition, 38 retention or use of telecommunications services provided to any division, 39 department or agency of the state, state officer or governmental unit and 40which pertains to individually identifiable individuals using such telecom-41 munication services shall constitute for purposes of the open records act 42 a record of the division, department or agency of the state, state officer 43 or governmental unit to which such records relate. The official custodian

of such records for the purposes of the open records act shall be the official custodian of the records of such division, department or agency

of the state, state officer or governmental unit. 

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 75-4709 is hereby repealed. 

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  $\mathbf{5}$ publication in the statute book.
