HOUSE BILL No. 2821

AN ACT concerning vocational education; relating to tuition rates for postsecondary students; amending K.S.A. 72-4433 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 72-4433 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-4433. The rate per hour of tuition for postsecondary students shall be fixed by each board subject to approval of the state board at the commencement of each school year for such school year. Such rate shall be an amount equal to 12½% of the local cost per enrollment hour for the school year ending June 30, 1982, and 15% of the local cost per enrollment hour for the state board of regents.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 72-4433 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
