AN ACT relating to criminal procedure; concerning search and administrative warrants; establishing how search and administrative warrants
may be issued in violation of health, safety, building or animal cruelty
laws or ordinances.

14 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

15 Section 1. In addition to other warrants provided by K.S.A. 22-2501 et seq., and amendments thereto, magistrates, upon showing of probable 16 17cause to believe a state, county or municipal law or ordinance has been 18 violated in relation to health, safety, building or animal cruelty, may issue 19 a warrant for the purpose of obtaining evidence of a violation. Warrants 20 may be obtained from a magistrate upon request of a law enforcement 21official of the state and state, county, municipal health, fire, building and 22 animal control personnel only after approval by a district attorney or 23 county attorney. A search warrant issued under this section shall be di-24rected to any law enforcement official of the state within the county where 25the warrant is to be executed, who shall serve the same. Other concerned 26 personnel may accompany the officer.

27 Sec. 2. (a) Property or evidence seized pursuant to a search warrant 28 may not be suppressed at a motion, trial or other proceeding, unless the 29 unlawful conduct of the law enforcement officer is shown to be 30 substantial.

(b) Any unlawful search or seizure shall be considered substantial and
in bad faith if the warrant was obtained with malicious purpose and without probable cause or was executed maliciously and willfully beyond the
authority of the warrant or with unnecessary severity.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
