9 AN ACT concerning adult care homes; relating to training of inspectors10 of adult care homes.

12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

13 Section 1. (a) Designated representatives of the department of 14 health and environment as the licensing agency and the state fire marshal 15with any required assistance of the county, city-county or multicounty 16 health departments or their designated representatives who perform in-17spections and investigations of adult care homes as defined in subsection 18 (a)(1) of K.S.A. 39-923, and amendments thereto, shall participate in a 19 10-day or longer training program for adult care home inspectors before 20such inspectors perform an inspection of an adult care home.

(b) The department of health and environment as the licensing
agency, by rules and regulations, shall develop and implement such training program after consulting with the fire marshal and other representatives described in subsection (a) regarding the requirements and standards such training program shall encompass.

26 As part of the training program to be an inspector of adult care (c) 27 homes, within the first 30 days of employment as an inspector, the trainee 28shall be assigned to an adult care home as defined in K.S.A. 39-923 for a 29 10-day full-time assignment to observe the actual operations of such fa-30 cility outside of the inspection and investigation process. Thereafter, every 31 two years, each inspector shall participate in a minimum of two full-time 32 days in onsite observation in an adult care home outside of the inspection 33 process.

34 (d) The department of health and environment shall monitor the in-35 spector training program and re-evaluate within a year whether it is more 36 beneficial to have: (1) One or two staff members provide all of the in-37 spector training in the state to ensure greater consistency or (2) allow 38 regional staff to provide most of the training in their region with one or 39 two staff persons from the department of health and environment over-40 seeing what is being taught in each regional training program for consistency between the regions in an effort to maintain consistency, efficiency 4142 and cost effectiveness.

43 (e) The department of health and environment shall provide written

guidance to its inspectors about when it is appropriate to express concern

to an adult care home administrator through verbal comments as opposed

to or in addition to including the concern in the written report provided

to the administrator at the conclusion of each inspection.

(f) This act shall be part of and supplemental to the adult care home $\mathbf{5}$ licensure act.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
