AN ACT requiring the provision of a course of instruction in the issues of senior citizens and long term-care requirements, by certain accred-ited schools. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. (a) The state board of education shall provide for a course of instruction in the issues of senior citizens and long-term care require-ments, which shall be required for all students graduating from an ac-credited high school in this state. The state board of education shall prescribe the school year, not (b) later than the 2004-2005 school year, in which the requirement of sub-section (a) shall become applicable and may provide for such waivers from the requirements as the board deems appropriate. Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
