9 AN ACT concerning criminal procedure; relating to criminal history; 10 amending K.S.A. 21-4715 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 21-4715 is hereby amended to read as follows: 21-14 4715. (a) The offender's criminal history shall be admitted in open court 15by the offender or determined by a preponderance of the evidence at the 16 sentencing hearing by the sentencing judge. (b) Except to the extent disputed in accordance with subsection (c), 1718 the summary of the offender's criminal history prepared for the court by 19 the state shall satisfy the state's burden of proof regarding an offender's 20criminal history. 21(c) Upon receipt of the criminal history worksheet prepared for the 22 court, the offender shall immediately notify the district attorney and the 23 court with written notice of any error in the proposed criminal history 24worksheet. Such notice shall specify the exact nature of the alleged error. 25The state shall have the burden of producing further evidence to satisfy 26 its burden of proof regarding any disputed part, or parts, of the criminal 27 history and the sentencing judge shall allow the state reasonable time to 28produce such evidence to establish the disputed portion of the criminal 29 history by a preponderance of the evidence. 30 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 21-4715 is hereby repealed. 31 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 32 publication in the statute book. 33 34 35
