AN ACT relating to highways; requiring an economic impact study to determine lost business revenue.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) If it is determined during the design of any highway construction project that any existing access from a highway to or from any business, including on and off ramps, shall be required to be closed in excess of 15 days, the secretary of transportation shall conduct an economic impact study to determine the approximate amount of damages such business may experience.

- (b) In addition to the economic impact study required under subsection (a), if access is closed for a period in excess of 15 days, the secretary of transportation shall provide for the construction of temporary access from such highway.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
