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AN ACT concerning the economic development initiatives fund; authorizing certain transfers therefrom; amending K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 794804 and repealing the existing section.

16 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

17Section 1. K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 79-4804 is hereby amended to read as 18follows: 79-4804. (a) After the transfer of moneys pursuant to K.S.A. 2001 19 Supp. 79-4806, and amendments thereto, an amount equal to 85% of the 20 balance of all moneys credited to the state gaming revenues fund shall 21be transferred and credited to the state economic development initiatives 22 fund. Expenditures from the state economic development initiatives fund 23shall be made in accordance with appropriations acts for the financing of 24such programs supporting and enhancing the existing economic founda-25tion of the state and fostering growth through the expansion of current, 26and the establishment and attraction of new, commercial and industrial 27enterprises as provided by this section and as may be authorized by law 28and not less than 1/2 of such money shall be distributed equally among 29 the congressional districts of the state. Except as provided by subsection 30 (g), all moneys credited to the state economic development initiatives 31 fund shall be credited within the fund, as provided by law, to an account 32 or accounts of the fund which are created by this section.

(b) There is hereby created the Kansas capital formation account in
the state economic development initiatives fund. All moneys credited to
the Kansas capital formation account shall be used to provide, encourage
and implement capital development and formation in Kansas.

(c) There is hereby created the Kansas economic development research and development account in the state economic development initiatives fund. All moneys credited to the Kansas economic development research and development account shall be used to promote, encourage and implement research and development programs and activities in Kansas and technical assistance funded through state educational institutions

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1 Kansas colleges and universities.

(d) There is hereby created the Kansas economic development en-2 3 dowment account in the state economic development initiatives fund. All 4 moneys credited to the Kansas economic development endowment account shall be accumulated and invested as provided in this section to 56 provide an ongoing source of funds which shall be used for economic 7 development activities in Kansas, including but not limited to continuing appropriations or demand transfers for programs and projects which shall 8 9 include, but are not limited to, specific community infrastructure projects 10 in Kansas that stimulate economic growth.

11 (e) Except as provided in subsection (f), the director of investments 12 may invest and reinvest moneys credited to the state economic development initiatives fund in accordance with investment policies established 13 14 by the pooled money investment board under K.S.A. 75-4232, and 15amendments thereto, in the pooled money investment portfolio. All mon-16 eys received as interest earned by the investment of the moneys credited 17to the state economic development initiatives fund shall be deposited in 18the state treasury and credited to the Kansas economic development en-19 dowment account of such fund.

20Moneys credited to the Kansas economic development endow-(f) 21ment account of the state economic development initiatives fund may be 22 invested in government guaranteed loans and debentures as provided by 23law in addition to the investments authorized by subsection (e) or in lieu 24of such investments. All moneys received as interest earned by the in-25vestment under this subsection of the moneys credited to the Kansas 26 economic development endowment account shall be deposited in the 27state treasury and credited to the Kansas economic development endow-28ment account of the state economic development initiatives fund.

29 (g) (1) In each fiscal year, the director of accounts and reports shall 30 make transfers in equal amounts on July 15 and January 15 which in the 31 aggregate equal \$2,000,000 from the state economic development initia-32 tives fund to the state water plan fund created by K.S.A. 82a-951, and 33 amendments thereto. No other moneys credited to the state economic 34 development initiatives fund shall be used for: (1) Water-related projects 35 or programs, or related technical assistance; or (2) any other projects or 36 programs, or related technical assistance, which meet one or more of the 37 long-range goals, objectives and considerations set forth in the state water resource planning act. 38

(2) (A) In fiscal years 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2006, the director of
accounts and reports shall make transfers in two equal parts on July 15
and January 15 which in the aggregate equals \$5,000,000 to the credit of

All expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the director of accounts and re-ports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the president of the Wich-ita state university or the president's designee. Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 79-4804 is hereby repealed. $\mathbf{5}$ Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
