HOUSE BILL No. 2968

AN ACT concerning vital statistics; relating to the department of health
and environment; concerning fees for obtaining birth certificates;
amending K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 65-2418 and repealing the existing section; also repealing K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 65-2418a.

Section 1. K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 65-2418 is hereby amended to read as 1516 follows: 65-2418. (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the 17secretary shall fix and charge the fees, if any, to be paid for certified copies 18 of certificates or for search of the files or records when no certified copy 19 is made. Fees for certified copies of certificates shall be fixed by rules 20 and regulations of the secretary except that the fee for the first copy of a 21birth or death certificate shall include a \$3 surcharge and the fee for each 22 additional copy of the same birth or death certificate requested at the 23same time shall include a \$1 surcharge. The secretary shall not charge 24any fee for a certified copy of a certificate or for a search of the files or 25records if the certificate or search is requested by a person who exhibits 26 correspondence from the United States veterans administration or the 27 Kansas commission on veterans' affairs which indicates that the person is 28applying for benefits from the United States veterans administration and 29 that such person needs the requested information to obtain such benefits, 30 except that, for a second or subsequent certified copy of a certificate or 31 search of the files requested by the person, the usual fee shall be charged. 32 The secretary may provide by rules and regulations for exemptions from 33 such fees. 34 (b) Subject to K.S.A. 65-2420, and amendments thereto, the national 35 office of vital statistics may be furnished copies or data it requires for

antional statistics. The state shall be reimbursed for the cost of furnishing
the data. The data shall not be used for other than statistical purposes by
the national office of vital statistics unless so authorized by the state registrar of vital statistics.

40 (c) (1) The secretary shall remit all moneys received by or for the
41 secretary from fees, charges or penalties to the state treasurer in accord42 ance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto.
43 Upon receipt of each such remittance, other than remittances for fees

3 (2) Upon receipt of any such remittance of a fee for a birth certificate, 33 \$4 of each such fee for the first copy of a birth certificate and 12 \$2 4 of each such fee for each additional copy of the same birth certificate 56 requested at the same time shall be remitted to the state treasurer in 7 accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall 8 9 deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the per-10 manent families account of the family and children investment fund cre-11 ated by K.S.A. 38-1808, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of any 12 such remittance of a fee for a death certificate, \$3 of each such fee for 13 the first copy of a death certificate and \$1 of each such fee for each 14 additional copy of the same death certificate requested at the same time 15shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions 16 of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such 17remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the district coroners fund created by K.S.A. 22a-18 19 245, and amendments thereto. The balance of the money received for a 20fee for a birth certificate shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. 2122 Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit 23the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the state general 24fund.

25Upon receipt of any fee for a certified copy of a birth, death, fetal (d)death, marriage or divorce certificate, \$1 of each such fee shall be remitted 26 to the state treasurer who shall deposit the entire amount of each such 27remittance in the state treasury and credit it to the vital statistics main-2829 tenance fee fund created by K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 65-2418b, and amend-30 ments thereto. For the purposes of the vital statistics maintenance fee 31 fund, the secretary of health and environment shall adopt rules and reg-32 ulations providing for an increase of \$1 in the fees charged by the state 33 registrar for providing a certified copy of a birth, death, fetal death, mar-34 riage or divorce certificate.

(e) The secretary of health and environment shall adopt rules and
regulations providing for an increase of \$1 in the fees charged by the state
registrar for providing a certified copy of a birth, death, fetal death, marriage or divorce certificate.
