- 14 (3) (4) multiply the quotient obtained under (2) by the enrollment of 15the district in the current school year. The product is the low enrollment weighting of the district. remainder obtained under (3); 16
- (5) multiply the quotient obtained under subsection (a)(2) of K.S.A. 172001 Supp. 72-6442, and amendments thereto, by the number of pupils, 18 19 *if any, subtracted from enrollment under (3);*

20 (6) add the product obtained under (5) to the product obtained under 21(4). The sum is the low enrollment weighting of the district.

- 22 (h) In determining low enrollment weighting under this section, the state board shall determine the district in which each pupil, not meeting 2324the requirements of K.S.A. 72-1046, and amendments thereto, for attend-
- 25ance at school in the district in which enrolled, is entitled to attend school 26 under the provisions of K.S.A. 72-1046, and amendments thereto.
