AN ACT concerning state finances; imposing passenger vehicle surcharges and commercial vehicle surcharges on turnpike travel; prescribing powers, duties and functions for the Kansas turnpike authority; amending K.S.A. 68-2004 and repealing the existing section.

14 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

15 New Section 1. (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section, 16 there is hereby imposed a passenger vehicle toll surcharge and a com-17mercial vehicle toll surcharge on the tolls for passenger and commercial 18 vehicles charged and collected by the Kansas turnpike authority on and 19 after July 1, 2002. Prior to July 1, 2002, and prior to July 1 of each year 20 thereafter, the Kansas turnpike authority shall determine the passenger 21vehicle toll surcharge rate and the commercial vehicle toll surcharge rate 22 in accordance with this section. Each passenger vehicle or commercial 23vehicle entering and exiting the turnpike within a metropolitan area shall 24be exempt from the surcharge imposed by this section.

25(b) Based on the passenger vehicle volume, the passenger vehicle 26 tolls paid and the distances traveled on the turnpike by passenger vehicles 27 during the preceding calendar year, the Kansas turnpike authority shall 28fix the amount of the surcharge to be charged on each passenger vehicle 29 toll commencing on July 1 of each year, to be in effect for the state fiscal 30 year commencing on such July 1, at a rate which is determined by the 31 Kansas turnpike authority to be the rate that would have yielded an average surcharge per passenger vehicle of \$.15 per passenger vehicle toll 32 33 during the preceding calendar year. Based on the commercial vehicle 34 volume, the commercial vehicle tolls paid and the distances traveled on 35 the turnpike by commercial vehicles during the preceding calendar year, 36 the Kansas turnpike authority shall fix the amount of the surcharge to be 37 charged on each commercial vehicle toll commencing on July 1 of each 38 year, to be in effect for the state fiscal year commencing on such July 1, 39 at a rate which is determined by the Kansas turnpike authority to be the 40rate that would have yielded an average surcharge per passenger vehicle 41 of \$.60 per commercial vehicle toll during the preceding calendar year. 42 Each such surcharge rate shall be expressed as a percentage and shall be 43 rounded up to the nearest \$.05 when applied and added to each toll

2	(c) The Kansas turnpike authority shall administer, charge and collect
3	the passenger vehicle toll surcharges and the commercial vehicle toll sur-
4	charges imposed by this section and shall remit the money received for
5	such surcharges to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions
6	of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such
7	remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state
8	treasury to the credit of the state general fund.
9	(d) As used in this section, "entering and exiting the turnpike within
10	a metropolitan area" means transit over only that portion of the turnpike
11	between two interchanges servicing a single city.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 68-2004 is hereby amended to read as follows: 682004. (a) The authority is hereby authorized and empowered to:

14 (1) Adopt bylaws for the regulation of its affairs and the conduct of 15 its business;

(2) adopt an official seal and alter the same at pleasure;

(3) maintain an office at such place or places within the state as itmay designate;

19 (4) sue and be sued in its own name, plead and be impleaded;

(5) determine the location, subject to the approval of the secretary of
transportation, of each turnpike project financed under the provisions of
this act, determine its design and the materials of construction, and construct, maintain, repair and operate the same;

(6) issue turnpike revenue bonds of the authority for any of its corporate purposes, payable solely from the tolls and revenues pledged for
their payment, and to refund its bonds, all as provided in this act;

(7) fix and revise from time to time and charge and collect tolls fortransit over each turnpike project constructed by it;

(8) adopt rules and regulations for the use of any such turnpike project, and adopt rules and regulations for traffic control on such project;
(9) acquire, hold and dispose of real and personal property in the

31 (9) acquire, hold and dispose of real and personal property in the 32 exercise of its powers and the performance of its duties under this act; 33 (10) a basis to the basis of the performance of the state of the

(10) designate the locations, and establish, limit and control such points of ingress to and egress from each turnpike project as may be necessary or desirable in the judgment of the authority to insure the proper operation and maintenance of such project, and to prohibit entrance to such project from any point or points not so designated;

(11) make and enter into all contracts and agreements necessary or
 incidental to the performance of its duties and the execution of its powers
 under this act;

(12) employ consulting engineers, attorneys, accountants, construction and financial experts, superintendents, managers, and such other
employees and agents as may be necessary in its judgment, and to fix their

(13) receive and accept from any federal agency grants for or in aid of the construction of any turnpike project, and to receive and accept aid or contributions from any source of either money, property, labor or other things of value, to be held, used and applied only for the purposes for $\mathbf{5}$ which such grants and contributions may be made; and

(14) do all acts and things necessary or convenient to carry out the powers expressly granted in this act; and

(15) fix, collect and remit the surcharges imposed by section 1, and amendments thereto.

(b) Violation of any of the rules and regulations adopted under this section shall be unlawful and subject to the penalties contained in K.S.A. 8-2116 and amendments thereto.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 68-2004 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
