8 9 AN ACT concerning the care and treatment for mentally ill persons; 10 relating to delivery of certain services; amending K.S.A. 39-1610 and 11 repealing the existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14 Section 1. K.S.A. 39-1610 is hereby amended to read as follows: 39-151610. (a) Prior to January 1, 1991, for the Osawatomie state hospital 16 catchment area, prior to July 1, 1992, for the Topeka state hospital catch-17ment area and prior to July 1, 1993, for the Larned state hospital catch-18 ment area, the secretary shall enter into contracts with mental health 19 centers so that there is a participating mental health center for each area 20of the state. Each participating mental health center entering into a con-21tract with the secretary under this section shall provide screening, treat-22 ment and evaluation, court ordered evaluation and other treatment serv-23ices pursuant to the care and treatment act for mentally ill persons.

(b) Subject to the provisions of this act and appropriations acts, the
secretary shall administer and disburse funds to each mental health center
for the coordination and provision of mental health services for all persons
who are residents of the service delivery area of such mental health
center.

(c) Subject to and in accordance with the provisions of this act and
appropriations acts, the secretary shall undertake, in cooperation with
participating mental health centers, the establishment and implementation of the mental health reform phased program.

(1) Beginning with the Osawatomie state hospital catchment area, the
 secretary shall enter into contracts with participating mental health cen ters to reduce the rated bed capacity of the Osawatomie state hospital as
 follows:

(A) One unit of 20 to 30 beds for adults shall be closed by June 30,1991;

(B) by June 30, 1992, an additional unit or units comprising 20 to 30beds shall be closed for adolescents; and

41 (C) by June 30, 1993, an additional unit or units comprising 20 to 30 42 adult beds shall be closed.

43 (2) For the Topeka state hospital catchment area, the secretary shall

enter into contracts with participating mental health centers to reduce
 the rated bed capacity of Topeka state hospital as follows:

3 (A) One or more units comprising 20 to 30 adolescent beds shall be 4 closed by June 30, 1993;

5 (B) an additional unit or units comprising 20 to 30 adult beds shall 6 be closed by June 30, 1994; and

7 (C) an additional unit or units comprising 20 to 30 adult beds shall 8 be closed by June 30, 1995.

9 (3) For the Larned state hospital catchment area, the secretary shall 10 enter into contracts with participating mental health centers to reduce 11 the rated bed capacity of Larned state hospital by closing one or more 12 units comprising 20 to 30 adult beds in each of the fiscal years ending 13 June 30, 1994, June 30, 1995, and June 30, 1996.

(d) The staff of each state psychiatric hospital and the staff of the
participating mental health centers in the catchment area of the state
psychiatric hospital shall develop and implement admission and discharge
criteria for all patients. The provisions of this section shall be incorporated
into all contracts entered into between the secretary and the participating
mental health centers.

20 (e) A participating mental health center may expend funds received 21 from the secretary to contract with a contracting agency for the purchase 22 of administrative, financial and other nonclinical services from such con-23 tracting agency as may be needed to assist the participating mental health 24 center to carry out the provisions of the contract entered into by the 25 center with the secretary.

26 (f) During any fiscal year, if the level of payments to be made to 27 participating mental health centers pursuant to contracts with the sec-28retary under this section are not equal to or greater than the level of such 29 payments to participating mental health centers for fiscal year 2001, then 30 participating mental health centers shall not be required to provide mental 31 health services under the mental health reform act to every person who 32 is a resident of the service delivery area of such mental health center and 33 who requests mental health services during such fiscal year.

34 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 39-1610 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.

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
