(a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, 15the definitions set forth in K.S.A. 25-4143, and amendments thereto, shall 16 be applicable to the provisions in this section. 17(2) As used in this section "regulated entity" means any person who 18 is required by law to be licensed by the insurance commissioner, or any 19 person who engages in a business or profession which is regulated by the 20 insurance commissioner, or any person employed by a company regulated 21by the insurance commissioner. 22 No regulated entity and no person or political committee acting (b) 23 on behalf of a regulated entity shall make a contribution to or on behalf 24of a person holding the office of insurance commissioner, to or on behalf 25of a candidate for the office of insurance commissioner or, to or on behalf 26 of a candidate committee of any such candidate. 27 No person holding the office of insurance commissioner shall (c) 28knowingly accept any contribution from any regulated entity or any per-29 son or political committee acting on behalf of such regulated entity. 30 (d) No candidate for the office of insurance commissioner shall know-31

ingly accept any contribution from any regulated entity or any person orpolitical committee acting on behalf of such regulated entity.

(e) No candidate committee of a candidate for the office of insurance
 commissioner shall knowingly accept any contribution from any regulated
 entity or any person or political committee acting on behalf of such reg ulated entity.

(f) Any person or entity violating the provisions of this act shall be
punished in the manner and be subject to the penalties prescribed by
K.S.A. 25-4181, and amendments thereto.
