(a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the definitions set forth in K.S.A. 25-4143, and amendments thereto, shall 16 17be applicable to the provisions in this section. (2) As used in this section "benefitting entity" means any person or 1819 business entity which: 20 (A) is a party or intervener to any litigation in which the attorney 21general appears on behalf of the State of Kansas or the attorney general 22 is required by statute to participate in such litigation; and 23 (B) receives any direct benefit, monetary or otherwise, if the attorney 24general wins all or any part of such litigation. 25(3) As used in this section, the term person shall also include any 26 subsidiary or parent entity of a person as such term is defined in K.S.A. 27 25-4143, and amendments thereto. 28No benefitting entity and no person or political committee acting (b) 29 on behalf of a benefitting entity shall make a contribution to or on behalf 30 of a person holding the office of attorney general, to or on behalf of a 31 candidate for the office of attorney general, to or on behalf of a candidate 32 committee of any such candidate. 33 No person holding the office of attorney general shall knowingly (c) 34 accept any contribution from any benefitting entity or any person or po-35 litical committee acting on behalf of such benefitting entity. 36 No candidate for the office of attorney general shall knowingly (d) 37 accept any contribution from any benefitting entity or any person or po-38 litical committee acting on behalf of such benefitting entity. 39 (e) No candidate committee of a candidate for the office of attorney 40general shall knowingly accept any contribution from any benefitting en-41 tity or any person or political committee acting on behalf of such bene-42 fitting entity. 43 (f) No benefitting entity and no person or political committee acting on behalf of a benefitting entity shall make a contribution to or on behalf
of a person who has held the office of attorney general and who is a
candidate for another public office or on behalf of a candidate committee
of any such candidate.

5 (g) No person who has held the office of attorney general and who 6 is a candidate for another public office shall knowingly accept any con-7 tribution from any benefitting entity or any person or political committee 8 acting on behalf of such benefitting entity.

9 (h) No person who has held the office of attorney general and who 10 is a candidate for another public office shall knowingly accept any con-11 tribution from any benefitting entity or any person or political committee 12 acting on behalf of such benefitting entity.

(i) Any person or entity violating the provisions of this act shall be
punished in the manner and be subject to the penalties prescribed by
K.S.A. 25-4181, and amendments thereto.
