10 AN ACT creating the Kansas council for interstate adult offender super-
11 vision; membership; duties.

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13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. (a) The Kansas council for interstate adult offender su-
15 pervision shall consist of the following members:

- 16 (1) The governor or the governor's designee;
17 (2) the chief justice of the supreme court or the chief justice's
18 designee;
19 (3) the attorney general or the attorney general's designee;
20 (4) a person representing crime victims groups appointed by the at-
21 torney general;
22 (5) one county attorney or district attorney appointed by the
23 governor;
24 (6) one private defense counsel appointed by the governor;
25 (7) the chairperson of the Kansas parole board or such chairperson's
26 designee;
27 (8) the secretary of corrections or the secretary's designee;
28 (9) two senators, one shall be appointed by the president of the senate
29 and one shall be appointed by the minority leader of the senate; and
30 (10) two representatives, one shall be appointed by the speaker of
31 the house of representatives and one shall be appointed by the minority
32 leader of the house of representatives.
33 (b) The appointments shall be made within 30 days after the effective
34 date of this act. The initial meeting of the council shall be convened within
35 60 days after the effective date of this act by the secretary of corrections
36 at a time and place designated by the secretary of corrections. The council
37 shall elect a chairperson and may elect any additional officers from among
38 its members necessary to discharge its duties.
39 (c) Meetings of the council subsequent to its initial meeting shall be
40 held and conducted in accordance with policies and procedures estab-
41 lished by the council.
42 (d) The council shall meet upon call of its chairperson as necessary
43 to carry out its duties under this act.

1 (e) Each member of the council appointed by the governor or the
2 attorney general shall be appointed for a term of four years. All other
3 members shall be appointed for a term of two years and shall continue
4 to serve during that time as long as the member occupies the position
5 which made the member eligible for the appointment. Each member
6 shall continue in office until a successor is appointed and qualifies. Mem-
7 bers shall be eligible for reappointment, and appointment may be made
8 to fill an unexpired term.

9 (f) The council shall oversee and administer the state's participation
10 in the interstate compact for adult offenders supervision, 2002 Senate Bill
11 No. 95, and amendments thereto, and shall develop policies concerning
12 the operations and procedures of the compact within the state. **[The**
13 **council shall appoint the compact administrator.]**

14 (g) Each member of the council shall receive compensation, subsis-
15 tence allowances, mileage and other expenses as provided for in K.S.A.
16 75-3223, and amendments thereto, for each day or part thereof actually
17 spent on council activities.

18 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the
19 later of July 1, 2002, or upon enactment into law by the 35th jurisdiction,
20 and its publication in the statute book.

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
