A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Governor and Members
of the Finance Council to proclaim an energy resources emergency.
WHEREAS, The price of natural gas has risen drastically in recent
months due to low supplies and high market demand; and
WHEREAS, The high price of natural gas, coupled with a cold winter,
has left many consumers struggling or unable to pay the high costs of
heating their homes and businesses; and
WHEREAS, The Governor, with the approval of the State Finance
Council, has authority pursuant to K.S.A. 74-619 to proclaim an energy
resources emergency when the supply of energy resources is insufficient
to meet demand and the public health, safety and welfare are threatened
thereby: Now, therefore,
Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas,
the Senate concurring therein: That the Governor is urged to proclaim
an energy resources emergency and the Members of the State Finance
Council are urged to approve such proclamation; and
Be it further resolved: That the Secretary of State is directed to send
an enrolled copy of this concurrent resolution to the Governor and each
Member of the State Finance Council.
