1 Session of 2002 2 **House Concurrent Resolution No. 5053** 3 4 $\mathbf{5}$ By Committee on Utilities 6 7 3-148 9 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Federal Trade Commis-10 sion to adopt and implement a national "do not call" registry. 11 12 WHEREAS, Most consumers agree that telephone solicitations are a 13 great annoyance and an invasion of privacy; and 14 WHEREAS, A number of states have enacted legislation to prohibit 15telephone solicitors from calling consumers who have registered their 16 telephone numbers with a "do not call" registry; and WHEREAS, The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) in January pro-1718 posed a national "do not call" registry to allow consumers nationwide to 19 remove their telephone numbers from lists that telephone solicitors use 20in making consumer calls; and 21WHEREAS, A national registry would benefit both consumers and 22 telephone solicitors by creating a single uniform nationwide registry, enabling consumers, with a single action, to remove their telephone num-2324bers from telephone solicitors' lists and establishing a single national set 25of rules for telephone solicitors' conduct; and 26 WHEREAS, The FTC has requested public comments by March 29, 27 2002, on the establishment of the national registry: Now, therefore, 28Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, 29 the Senate concurring therein: That the legislature of the state of Kansas 30 supports the establishment of a national "do not call" registry and urges 31 the FTC to act in a timely manner to adopt and implement such a registry; 32 and 33 *Be it further resolved:* That the Secretary of State be directed to send six enrolled copies of this resolution to the Office of the Secretary, Room 34 35 159, Federal Trade Commission, 600 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Wash-36 ington, DC 20580. 37 38 39 40
