AN ACT concerning district courts; relating to the purchase of supplies
and equipment; amending K.S.A. 19-260b and repealing the existing
section.

13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 19-260b is hereby amended to read as follows: 19-15260b. The county purchasing officer, by and in conjunction with the board 16 of county commissioners, shall purchase all supplies and equipment and 17approve all contracts, service and supply agreements and all other trans-18 actions that necessitate expenditure of county funds for the county and 19 for each and every office and department thereof,. The county purchasing 20 officer shall keep a true and accurate account of all such purchases so 21made, and shall make a report upon request by the board of county com-22 missioners to the board of all purchases made and entered into and the office or department for which made for each office and department of 2324the county. Upon request by the board of county commissioners, the 25county purchasing officer shall provide a report of such purchases. Each 26 and every officeholder and department head and each and every em-27 ployee thereof in the county and the judge or judges of the district court 28in the county shall be required to make requisition for all purchases of 29 supplies and equipment contracts, service and supply agreements and 30 other transactions that necessitate the expenditure of county funds per-31 taining to their respective offices and departments through the office of 32 the county purchasing officer. Such requisition shall be in the form and 33 manner prescribed by the board of county commissioners in conjunction 34 with the county purchasing officer, except that the board of county com-35 missioners may authorize such officeholders, department heads or em-36 ployees to make emergency purchases or small purchases of less than 37 \$2,000 on the open market. The county purchasing officer shall purchase 38 all supplies and equipment and negotiate all contracts, service and supply 39 agreements and other transactions that necessitate the expenditure of any 40county funds in the amount of \$2,000 or more on the basis of competitive 41 bids, except that competitive bids need not be required for contractual 42 services where no competition exists. Bids shall be based on at least three 43 competitive bids when reasonably possible. All such contracts and purchases made under the provisions of this act, for which competitive bids
are required, shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, taking
into consideration conformity with the specifications, terms of delivery,
and other conditions imposed in the call for bids. The county purchasing
officer shall have the power to decide as to the lowest responsible bidder
for such purchases, and the county purchasing officer may reject any or
all bids.

8 The county purchasing officer is hereby authorized to maintain a stock 9 room and stationery supply store of expendable items for immediate req-10 uisition as needed.

11 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 19-260b is hereby repealed.

12 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 13 publication in the statute book.
