AN ACT concerning retirement and pensions; relating to the Kansas
public employees retirement system; death benefits for certain employees of state educational institutions; amending K.S.A. 74-4927g
and K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 74-4927b and repealing the existing sections.

14 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 74-4927b is hereby amended to read 1516 as follows: 74-4927b. (1) For the purposes of providing the "insured death 17benefit" and "insured disability benefit" as prescribed in K.S.A. 74-4927, 18and amendments thereto, and for the purposes of providing the "acci-19 dental death benefit" as prescribed in subsection (2) of K.S.A. 74-4916, 20 and amendments thereto, to those members of the faculty and other per-21 sons employed by educational institutions under the management of the 22 state board of education who are receiving assistance in the purchase of 23retirement annuities as provided in K.S.A. 74-4925, and amendments 24thereto, the term "member" as used in subsection (2) of K.S.A. 74-4916, 25and amendments thereto, and in K.S.A. 74-4927, and amendments thereto, shall include the aforementioned members of the faculty and 26 27 other persons employed by educational institutions under the manage-28ment of the state board of education and who are receiving such 29 assistance.

30 Each institution under the state board of education furnishing (2)31 such assistance shall pay to the Kansas public employees retirement sys-32 tem in such manner as the board of trustees shall prescribe each payroll 33 period an amount sufficient to pay the employer's contribution to the 34 group insurance reserve as provided in K.S.A. 74-4927, and amendments 35 thereto, and an amount sufficient to pay the amount of the employer's 36 contribution attributable to the accidental death benefit as prescribed in 37 subsection (2) of K.S.A. 74-4916, and amendments thereto. Subsection (2) 38 of K.S.A. 74-4932, and amendments thereto, shall also apply in deter-39 mining such contributions and benefits.

(3) Each such institution under the state board of education shall
maintain a file of the beneficiaries named by the persons covered under
the provisions of this act in the form and manner as prescribed by the

43 board of trustees.

1 (4) In the event that a member of the faculty or other person as 2 herein defined becomes eligible for the insured disability benefit, the 3 respective educational institutions under the board of education herein-4 before described shall continue to provide the assistance including the 5 payment of employers and employees contributions in the purchase of 6 the retirement annuities provided in K.S.A. 74-4925, and amendments 7 thereto, until the date of retirement.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 74-4927g is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-8 4927g. (1) For the purposes of providing the "insured death benefit" and 9 10 "long-term disability benefit" as prescribed in K.S.A. 74-4927, and 11 amendments thereto, and for the purposes of providing the "accidental death benefit" as prescribed in subsection (2) of K.S.A. 74-4916, and 12amendments thereto, to all employees employed by the state board of 13 14 regents or by educational institutions under the state board of regents 15who are fulfilling the two-year service requirement under subsection (a) 16 of K.S.A. 74-4925, and amendments thereto, on and after the first day of 17the first payroll period of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1985, the term 18"member" as used in subsection (2) of K.S.A. 74-4916, and amendments 19 thereto, and K.S.A. 74-4927a, and amendments thereto, and as used in 20this section, shall include the aforementioned employees.

21(2) The employer of any member shall pay to the Kansas public em-22 ployees retirement system in such manner as the board of trustees shall prescribe, beginning with the first day of the first payroll period of the 2324fiscal year ending June 30, 1985, and each payroll period thereafter, an 25amount sufficient to pay the amount of the employer's contribution at-26 tributable to the accidental death benefit as prescribed in subsection (2) 27of K.S.A. 74-4916, and amendments thereto, and an amount sufficient to 28pay the employer's contribution to the group insurance reserve as pro-29 vided in subsection (4) of K.S.A. 74-4927, and amendments thereto.

(3) The employer of any member shall maintain a file of the beneficiaries named by the persons covered under this section in the form and
manner as prescribed by the board of trustees.

(4) Coverage under the plan of death and long-term disability ben efits shall begin with the first day of the first payroll period of the fiscal
 year ending June 30, 1985, for such member and other persons as defined
 in this section.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 74-4927g and K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 74-4927b are hereby
 repealed.
