Battery against a law enforcement officer is a battery, 16 as defined in K.S.A. 21-3412 and amendments thereto: 17(a) (1) Committed against a uniformed or properly identified state, county or city law enforcement officer other than a state correctional 18 19 officer or employee, a city or county correctional officer or employee, a juvenile correctional facility officer or employee or a juvenile detention 20 21facility officer or employee, while such officer is engaged in the perform-22 ance of such officer's duty; 23 (2) committed against a state correctional officer or employee by a 24person in custody of the secretary of corrections, while such officer or employee is engaged in the performance of such officer's or employee's 26 duty; (3)committed against a juvenile correctional facility officer or em-28ployee by a person confined in such juvenile correctional facility, while 29 such officer or employee is engaged in the performance of such officer's 30 or employee's duty; 31 (4) committed against a juvenile detention facility officer or employee 32 by a person confined in such juvenile detention facility, while such officer 33 or employee is engaged in the performance of such officer's or employee's 34 duty; or committed against a city or county correctional officer or em-(5)ployee by a person confined in a city holding facility or county jail facility, while such officer or employee is engaged in the performance of such 38 officer's or employee's duty. 39 (b) Battery against a law enforcement officer as defined in subsection (a)(1) is a class A person misdemeanor. 1 (1) "Correctional institution" means any institution or facility under 2 the supervision and control of the secretary of corrections.

3 (2) "State correctional officer or employee" means any officer or em4 ployee of the Kansas department of corrections or any independent con5 tractor, or any employee of such contractor, working at a correctional
6 institution.

7 (3) "Juvenile correctional facility officer or employee" means any of-8 ficer or employee of the juvenile justice authority or any independent 9 contractor, or any employee of such contractor, working at a juvenile 10 correctional facility, as defined in K.S.A. 38-1602 and amendments 11 thereto.

(4) "Juvenile detention facility officer or employee" means any officer
or employee of a juvenile detention facility as defined in K.S.A. 38-1602
and amendments thereto.

(5) "City or county correctional officer or employee" means any correctional officer or employee of the city or county or any independent
contractor, or any employee of such contractor, working at a city holding
facility or county jail facility.
