8 9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas mortgage business act; relating to ex-10 emptions; amending K.S.A. 9-2202 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 9-2202 is hereby amended to read as follows: 9-14 2202. The following are exempt from the licensing requirements of this 15act: 16 (a) Any bank, savings bank, trust company, savings and loan associa-17tion, building and loan association, industrial loan company or credit un-18ion organized, chartered or authorized under the laws of the United States 19 or of any state which is authorized to make loans and to receive deposits; 20 any entity directly or indirectly regulated by an agency of the (b) 21 United States or of any state which is a subsidiary or affiliate of any entity 22 listed in subsection (a) if 25% or more of such entity's common stock is 23owned by any entity listed in subsection (a); 24any person who is registered as a loan broker pursuant to K.S.A. (c) 2550-1001 et seq., and amendments thereto, or who is licensed as a super-26 vised lender pursuant to K.S.A. 16a-2-301 et seq., and amendments 27thereto; 28(d) the United States of America, the state of Kansas, any other state, 29 or any agency or instrumentality of any governmental entity; and 30 (e) any individual who with their own funds for their own investment 31 makes a purchase money mortgage or finances the sale of their own prop-32 erty, except that any person who enters into more than five such invest-33 ments or sales in any twelve-month period shall be subject to all provisions 34 of this act; and 35 (f) an insurance agent as defined in K.S.A. 40-239, and amendments 36 thereto, if the insurance agent acts on behalf of only one licensee or exempt 37 entity and has entered into a written contract under the terms of which 38 the licensee or exempt entity agrees to accept responsibility for all mort-39 gage business conducted on behalf of such licensee or entity by the insur-40ance agent. The commissioner may institute appropriate regulatory proceedings against the licensee or exempt entity for the conduct of an 4142 insurance agent that violates this act. 43 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 9-2202 is hereby repealed.
