

# SENATE BILL No. 604

AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, for the department of health and environment; authorizing certain transfers and imposing certain restrictions and limitations.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

Section 1. (a) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, appropriations are hereby made and restrictions and limitations are hereby imposed and transfers, receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing are hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

(b) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of K.S.A. 75-6702 and amendments thereto.

## DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT

(a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state general fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, the following:

WIC farmer's market nutrition program ..... \$30,000

*Provided*, That no expenditures shall be made by the above agency from the WIC farmer's market nutrition program account until such state expenditures have been matched by federal grant moneys which have been received in the amount of \$70,000 or greater: *Provided further*, That expenditures shall be made from this account to provide participants in the special supplemental nutrition program for women, infants and children with vouchers to purchase fresh, nutritious, unprocessed produce at farmer's markets: *And provided further*, That the WIC farmer's market nutrition program shall be administered by the division of health, bureau for children, youth and families, nutrition and WIC services section of the above agency.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
