K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 31-150 is hereby amended to read as 16 follows: 31-150. (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b), the 17construction of school buildings shall comply with the requirements of the 1985 edition of the uniform building code, volume I, and the 1985 1819 edition of the uniform mechanical code, of the international conference 20 of building officials 2000 edition of the international building code, of the international code council and the 2000 edition of the uniform mechanical 2122 code as published by the international association of plumbing and me-23chanical officials or the 2000 edition of the international mechanical code 24as published by the international codes council. All electric wiring shall 25conform to requirements of the 1984 1999 issue of the national electric 26code of the national fire protection association. Minimum plumbing 27requirements shall meet the 1985 2000 edition of the uniform plumbing 28code issued by the international association of plumbing and mechanical 29officials or the 2000 edition of the international plumbing code as pub-30 lished by the international codes council. The construction of school build-31 ings shall comply with any special or more restrictive provisions of a 32 municipality.

33 (b) The construction of mobile, modular, portable or relocatable 34 school buildings shall conform to the requirements of the 1985 2000 35 edition of the life safety code as adopted and the 1999 edition of manu-36 *factured housing as published* by the national fire protection association. Minimum plumbing requirements shall meet the 1985 2000 edition of 37 38 the uniform plumbing code issued by the international association of plumbing and mechanical officials or the 2000 edition of the international 39 40plumbing code as published by the international codes council.

(c) The construction of all school buildings shall conform to the provisions for making buildings and facilities accessible to, and usable by,
persons with a disability, as required by K.S.A. 58-1301 through 58-1311,

1 and amendments thereto.

2 No contract shall be let for the construction of any school build-(d) 3 ing, and it shall be illegal to pay out any public funds for the construction of a school building until the plans for such building shall: (1) Bear the 4 seal of an architect or a professional engineer licensed by the state board 56 of technical professions of the state of Kansas certifying that the plans 7 meet the applicable requirements of this act; and (2) be submitted to the state board of education for approval as to compliance with such 8 9 requirements.

10 (e) The provisions of subsections (c) and (d) of this section shall not 11 apply to any building or structure operated or used for any purpose by, or located upon the land of any community college, area vocational school, 12 area vocational-technical school, technical college, or municipal univer-13 14sity, institution under the governance of the state board of regents or 15other institutions of post secondary education as defined by K.S.A. 74-16 3249, and amendments thereto. Prior to construction of any new building or remodeling of any existing building, all community colleges, area vo-17cational schools, area vocational-technical schools, technical colleges and, 1819 any municipal university, institutions under the governance of the state 20board of regents or other institutions of post secondary education as defined by K.S.A. 74-3249, and amendments thereto, shall submit to the 2122 state fire marshal a code footprint for evaluation and approval of the fire/ life safety features of such buildings. 23

(f) The relocation of school buildings to which the provisions of subsection (b) apply shall not be construed to be construction or reconstruction under the provisions, or for the purposes, of this section.

(g) The construction or reconstruction of any school building to
which the provisions of this section were applicable prior to January 26,
July 1, 2003, shall be governed by the provisions of this section
which were in effect on the date on which the contract for such construction or reconstruction was entered into.

(h) The state fire marshal shall adopt rules and regulations specifying
those subsequent editions of the codes enumerated in subsections (a) and
(b) which the state fire marshal has determined provide protection equivalent to those editions specified herein. Compliance with any subsequent
edition specified by such rules and regulations shall be considered compliance with the edition of the code specified by this section.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 31-150 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.

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
