9 AN ACT concerning mortgage registration fees; relating to the use of 10 the moneys derived therefrom; amending K.S.A. 79-3107b and re-11 pealing the existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14 Section 1. K.S.A. 79-3107b is hereby amended to read as follows: 79-3107b. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), the county treasurer shall 15 pay quarterly to the state treasurer, commencing on October 1, 1990, 16 17\$.01 of each \$.26 paid to the county treasurer during the preceding cal-18 endar quarter from mortgage registration fees under K.S.A. 79-3101 to 19 79-3107, inclusive, and amendments thereto, and credited to the county general fund under K.S.A. 79-3104, and amendments thereto. All such 2021moneys paid to the state treasurer shall be deposited in the state treasury 22 and credited to the heritage trust fund. 23 No payments under subsection (a) shall be made by the county (b)

treasurer to the state treasurer during any calendar year in excess of a total of \$100,000. All moneys collected in excess of this amount which under subsection (a) would be paid to the state treasurer shall be credited to the county general fund. Such moneys which are credited to the county general fund shall be expended for historical and cultural heritage purposes. The term "cultural heritage" shall include, but not be limited to,

30 the culture, language, beliefs and customs of a distinguishable group of 31 people.

32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 79-3107b is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
