WHEREAS, Justin Dyer's athletic and academic achievements deserve honorary recognition by the State of Kansas; and

Justin's career record is 145 wins and only 3 losses with an amazing streak of 95 consecutive wins.

WHEREAS, Justin's academic achievements warrant higher praise than his athletic achievements. Despite his success and dedication to athletics, Justin maintains a 3.9 grade point average. He was named an Academic All-American by the National Wrestling Coaches Association. Moreover, Justin is a member of the National Honor Society; Falcon Honor Roll; Spanish Honors Club and Calculus Club. In addition to excelling in the high school classroom, Justin has completed 22 hours of credit at Johnson County Community College; and
