8 9 AN ACT concerning state finances; relating to appropriations and de-10 mand transfers from the state general fund; amending K.S.A. 75-6702 and repealing the existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 75-6702 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-156702. (a) The last appropriation bill passed in any regular session of the 16 legislature shall be the omnibus reconciliation spending limit bill. Each 17bill which is passed during a regular session of the legislature and which 18 appropriates or transfers money from the state general fund for the en-19 suing fiscal year shall contain a provision that such bill shall take effect 20 and be in force from and after the effective date of the omnibus recon-21ciliation spending limit bill for that regular session of the legislature or 22 from and after such effective date and a subsequent date or an event 23occurring after such effective date.

24(b) The maximum amount of expenditures and demand transfers 25from the state general fund that may be authorized by act of the legisla-26 ture during a regular session of the legislature for the ensuing fiscal year 27 or prescribed by statute for such fiscal year shall be subject to the follow-28ing limitation:

29 (1) During the 2003 and 2004 regular sessions of the legislature, the 30 maximum amount authorized to be expended or transferred by demand 31 transfer from the state general fund for the ensuing fiscal year is hereby 32 fixed so that there will be an ending balance in the state general fund for 33 such fiscal year that is equal to \$1 or more;

34 (2) during the 2005 regular session of the legislature, the maximum 35 amount authorized to be expended or transferred by demand transfer 36 from the state general fund for the ensuing fiscal year is hereby fixed so that there will be an ending balance in the state general fund for such 37 fiscal year that is equal to 2% or more of the total amount authorized to 38 39 be expended or transferred by demand transfer from the state general 40fund in such fiscal year;

41 (3) during the 2006 regular session of the legislature, the maximum 42 amount authorized to be expended or transferred by demand transfer

from the state general fund for the ensuing fiscal year is hereby fixed so 43

that there will be an ending balance in the state general fund for such

fiscal year that is equal to 4% or more of the total amount authorized to

be expended or transferred by demand transfer from the state general fund in such fiscal year; and

(4) during the 1994 2007 regular session of the legislature and each $\mathbf{5}$ regular session of the legislature thereafter, is hereby fixed so that there will be an ending balance in the state general fund for the ensuing fiscal year that is equal to $\frac{71/2\%}{5\%}$ 5% or more of the total amount authorized to be expended or transferred by demand transfer from the state general fund in such fiscal year.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 75-6702 is hereby repealed.
