AN ACT amending and supplementing the Kansas consumer protection act; declaring certain representations regarding certain diesel fuel to be a deceptive act or practice; providing penalties and remedies therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) It is a deceptive act or practice for a supplier to represent that diesel fuel is or contains soydiesel or biodiesel, or otherwise to represent that diesel fuel is made from renewable resources, unless not less than 2% of the diesel fuel mixture is mono-alkyl esters derived from vegetable oil or animal fat, as determined in accordance with specification D 6751-02, issued March, 2002, by the American society of testing and materials.

- (b) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas consumer protection act.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
