

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period beginning the day after the preceding general election through the 1 calendar year following such election; 2

(5) a treasurer shall file only the annual report required by 3 subsection (4) for those years when the candidate is not partici-4 $\mathbf{5}$ pating in a primary or general election.

(b) Each report required by this section shall state:

Cash on hand on the first day of the reporting period; (1)

the name and address of each person who has made one or 8 (2)9 more contributions in an aggregate amount or value in excess of 10 \$50 during the election period together with the amount and date of such contributions, including the name and address of every 11 lender, guarantor and endorser when a contribution is in the form 1213 of an advance or loan;

14 (3) the aggregate amount of all proceeds from bona fide sales 15of political materials such as, but not limited to, political campaign pins, buttons, badges, flags, emblems, hats, banners and literature; 16 (4) the aggregate amount of contributions for which the name 17

and address of the contributor is not known; 18

each contribution, rebate, refund or other receipt not oth-19 (5) 20 erwise listed; 21

the total of all receipts; (6)

22 the name and address of each person to whom expenditures (7)have been made in an aggregate amount or value in excess of \$50, 23with the amount, date, and purpose of each ; the names and ad-2425dresses of all persons to whom any loan or advance has been made; when an expenditure is made by payment to an advertising agency, 26 public relations firm or political consultants for disbursement to 27 vendors, the report of such expenditure shall show in detail the 28name of each such vendor and the amount, date and purpose of 29 30 the payments to each;

31 (8) the name and address of each person from whom an in-32 kind contribution was received or who has paid for personal services provided without charge to or for any candidate, candidate 33 committee, party committee or political committee, if the contri-34 35 bution is in excess of \$50 and is not otherwise reported under 36 subsection (b)(7), and the amount, date and purpose of the 37 contribution:

(9) the aggregate of all expenditures not otherwise reported 38 under this section; and 39

(10) the total of expenditures. 40

(c) Treasurers of candidates and of candidate committees shall 41

42 be required to itemize, as provided in subsection (b)(2), only the

purchase of tickets or admissions to testimonial events by a person 43

who purchases such tickets or admissions in an aggregate amount or value in excess of \$50 per event, or who purchases such a ticket or admission at a cost exceeding \$25 per ticket or admission. All other purchases of tickets or admissions to testimonial events shall be reported in an aggregate amount and shall not be subject to the limitations specified in K.S.A. 25-4154, and amendments thereto.

(d) If a contribution or other receipt from a political committee 8 9 is required to be reported under subsection (b), the report shall 10 include the full name of the organization with which the political 11 committee is connected or affiliated or, name or description sufficiently describing the affiliation or, if the committee is not con-12nected or affiliated with any one organization, the trade, profes-13 14sion or primary interest of the political committee as reflected by 15the statement of purpose of such organization.

16 (e) The commission may require any treasurer to file an 17 amended report for any period for which the original report filed 18 by such treasurer contains material errors or omissions, and notice 19 of the errors or omissions shall be part of the public record. The 20 amended report shall be filed within 30 days after notice by the 21 commission.

(f) The commission may require any treasurer to file a report for any period for which the required report is not on file, and notice of the failure to file shall be part of the public record. Such report shall be filed within five days after notice by the commission.

(g) For the purpose of any report required to be filed pursuant to subsection (a) by the treasurer of any candidate seeking nomination by convention or caucus or by the treasurer of the candidate's committee or by the treasurer of any party committee or political committee, the date of the convention or caucus shall be considered the date of the primary election.

(h) If a report is sent by certified or registered mail on or be fore the day it is due, the mailing shall constitute receipt by that
office.

Section 1. Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-4149 is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-4149. (a) All contributions and other receipts received and expenditures made from and including the January 1 first day following one general election date the date of the general election until and including the next ensuing primary election date shall be allocated to the

3	(b) For the purposes of allocating, pursuant to subsection (a), con-
4	tributions to or expenditures by a candidate seeking nomination by con-
5	vention or caucus or such candidate's candidate committee, the date of
6	such convention or caucus shall be considered the primary election date.
7	Sec. 3. K.S.A. 25-4153a is hereby amended to read as follows:
8	25-4153a. (a) No registered lobbyist, political committee or person,
9	other than an individual, shall make a contribution after January 1
10	the day preceding the first day of the regular session of the legislature of
11	each year and prior to adjournment sine die of the regular session
12	of the legislature or at any other time in which the legislature is
13	in session to a:
14	(1) Legislator;
15	(2) candidate for membership in the legislature;
16	(3) state officer elected on a statewide basis;
17	(4) candidate for state officer elected on a statewide basis;
18	(5) candidate committee of persons described in paragraphs
19	(1) through (4); or
20	(6) political committee established by a state committee of any
21	political party and designated as a recognized political committee
22	for the senate or house of representatives.
23	(b) No legislator, officer, candidate or committee described in
24	paragraphs (1) through (6) of subsection (a) shall accept or solicit
25	any contribution as defined by K.S.A. 25-4143, and amendments
26	thereto, from any registered lobbyist, political committee or per-
27	son, other than an individual, during such period of time described
28	in subsection (a).
