AN ACT designating a portion of United States highway 400 as the 903rd ordnance ammunition company by-pass.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. From the junction of United States highway 400 with Lyon road in Labette county, east on United States highway 400 through the city of Parsons to the junction of United States highway 400 with Queens road, is hereby designated as the 903rd ordnance ammunition company by-pass. The secretary of transportation shall place signs along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the 903rd ordnance ammunition company by-pass, except that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs. The secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
