10 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; providing for the independent order
11 of odd fellows license plate.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2004, any owner or lessee of
15 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of
16 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with
17 the provisions of this section, may be issued one independent order of
18 odd fellows license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such
19 license plates shall be issued for the same time as other license plates
20 upon proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as pro-
21 vided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and the presentation of
22 the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection
23 (b).

24 (b) The board of directors for the independent order of odd fellows
25 may authorize the use of their logo to be affixed on license plates as
26 provided by this section. Any royalty payment received pursuant to this
27 section shall be paid to the board and shall be used to support the dif-
28 ferent charities of the independent order of odd fellows. Any motor ve-
29 hicle owner or lessee annually may apply to the board for the use of such
30 logo. Upon annual application and payment to the board in an amount of
31 not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 as a logo use royalty payment for
32 each license plate to be issued, the board shall issue to the motor vehicle
33 owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use authorization state-
34 ment, which shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at
35 the time of registration.

36 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may
37 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such per-
38 son's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished by
39 the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plates shall
40 provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in sub-
41 section (b). Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck
42 and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made by the
43 owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon

1 forms furnished by the director.

2 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
3 transferable to any other person.

4 (e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made an-
5 nually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the man-
6 ner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
7 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
8 such applicant provides the annual logo use authorization statement pro-
9 vided for in subsection (b). If such logo use authorization statement is
10 not presented at the time of registration, the applicant shall be required
11 to comply with K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the
12 license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

13 (f) The board of directors for the independent order of odd fellows
14 shall:

15 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates authorized
16 by this section; and

17 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
18 where applicants can call the board for information concerning the ap-
19 plication process or the status of their license plate application.

20 (g) The board of directors for the independent order of odd fellows,
21 with the approval of the director of vehicles and subject to the availability
22 of materials and equipment, shall design a plate to be issued under the
23 provisions of this section.

24 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
25 publication in the statute book.
