9 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; concerning the installation of air10 bags.

12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person who, without the knowledge of the vehicle's owner or the person requesting the installa-tion, reinstallation or replacement of a motor vehicle air bag, to install or reinstall any air bag or other component of the vehicle's inflatable re-straint system knowing that the air bag installation is not in accordance with federal safety regulations applicable to that specific line-make, model, and model year vehicle and upon conviction shall be guilty of a class A nonperson misdemeanor.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person who, without the knowledge of the vehicle's owner or the person requesting the installation, reinstal-lation or replacement of a motor vehicle air bag, to install, reinstall or replace a motor vehicle air bag or other component of the vehicle's in-flatable restraint system with an air bag or other component of a vehicle's inflatable restraint system knowing that the air bag was previously in-stalled in another motor vehicle and upon conviction shall be guilty of a class A nonperson misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
