AN ACT concerning elections; relating to the timing of placing special questions on the ballot.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) When a question submitted election is to be conducted by the county election officer on the same date as a regularly scheduled election, the municipality or other local unit of government calling for such questions submitted election shall:

- (1) Complete all legal requirements necessary and precedent to the call of for such election; and
- (2) notify and provide the question to be printed on the ballot to the county election officer in accordance with the following schedule:
- (A) For any regularly scheduled general election, by the date of the county canvass of the preceding primary election, or if no primary election was held, by the date upon which such county canvass would have been held.
- (B) For any regularly scheduled primary election, by the deadline date for candidate filing for such primary election.
- (b) For the purposes of this section, "question submitted election" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in K.S.A. 25-2104, and amendments thereto.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
