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| 2 | Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: |
| 3 | Section 1. (a) This section shall be known and may be cited as the |
| 4 | emergency contraception education act. |
| 15 | (b) As used in this section: |
| 16 | (1) "Department" means the Kansas department of health and |
| 17 | environment. |
| 18 | (2) "Emergency contraception" means a drug or device that meets |
| 19 | both of the following criteria: (A) It is used after sexual relations; and (B) |
| 20 | it prevents pregnancy by preventing ovulation, fertilization of an egg or |
| 21 | implantation of an egg in a uterus. |
| 22 | (3) "Institution of higher education" means a degree- or certificate- |
| 23 | granting public or private college, university or community college. |
| 24 | (c) The department shall develop and disseminate to the public, |
| 25 | within the limits of appropriations and donations available therefor, in- |
| 26 | formation on emergency contraception. The department may disseminate |
| 27 | such information directly or through arrangements with nonprofit organ- |
| 28 | izations; consumer groups; institutions of higher education; federal, state |
| 29 | or local agencies; clinics; and the media. Such information shall include |
