AN ACT concerning agriculture; relating to livestock; prescribing certain
 unlawful acts and providing penalties therefor.

12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

13 Section 1. (a) In order to preserve free and private enterprise, pre-14 vent monopoly and protect consumers, a processor of pork or limited 15partnership in which a processor holds partnership shares as a general 16 partner or partnership shares as a limited partner shall not: (1) Contract 17for the production of hogs of which the processor is the owner; or (2)18own hogs, except that such processor may own hogs for 30 days before 19 such hogs are manufactured, processed or prepared for sale as pork 20products.

(b) Hogs owned by a processor in violation of this section on the
effective date of this act shall be sold, slaughtered or otherwise disposed
of on or before June 30, 2008.

(c) Violation of the provisions of this section shall subject the violator to a fine of not more than \$50,000. The district courts of this state may prevent and restrain violations of this section through the issuance of an injunction or other equitable and legal relief which the court may find appropriate. The attorney general or district or county attorney shall institute suits on behalf of the state to enforce the provisions of this act.

30 (d) The provisions of this section shall be part of and supplemental 31 to the provisions of K.S.A. 17-5901 *et seq.*, and amendments thereto.

32 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 33 publication in the statute book.
