9	AN ACT concerning the juvenile justice authority; relating to employees
10	thereof; amending K.S.A. 2002 Supp. 75-7055 and repealing the ex-
11	isting section.

13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
14	Section 1. K.S.A. 2002 Supp. 75-7055 is hereby amended to read as
15	follows: 75-7055. (<i>a</i>) All juvenile corrections officers and those employees
16	within the juvenile corrections officer series first employed on and after
17	July 1, 2000, shall be required to be at least 21 years of age, shall possess
18	no felony convictions, and shall meet such physical agility requirements
19	as set by the commissioner.
20	(b) On and after July 1, 2003, the appointing authority, in such per-
21	son's discretion may hire a juvenile corrections officer or employee within
22	the juvenile corrections officer series who does not meet the age require-
23	ment set forth in subsection (a) but who is at least 18 years of age, is hired
24	to work no more than part-time and is enrolled in at least 6 hours or
25	credits in an accredited post-secondary institution as a student in a crim-
26	inal justice, human services or other related field as determined by the
27	appointing authority. Such employee shall only be employed in open units
28	in minimum or medium security facilities and shall not be employed in a
29	maximum security facility or closed unit in a minimum or medium secu-
30	rity facility.
31	Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2002 Supp. 75-7055 is hereby repealed.
32	Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
33	publication in the statute book.
