AN ACT concerning crimes and punishment; exposing a child to the manufacturing of a controlled substance.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Exposing a child to the manufacturing of a controlled substance is intentionally or unintentionally but recklessly causing or permitting a child under the age of 18 years to be placed in a situation in which the child's life, body or health may be injured or endangered as a direct or indirect result of any act intended to further the manufacture, in whole or in part, of a controlled substance.

- (b) Exposing a child to the manufacturing of a controlled substance is a severity level 9, person felony.
- (c) As used in this section, "controlled substances" and "manufacture" shall have the meanings ascribed to such terms in K.S.A. 65-4101, and amendments thereto.
- (d) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the Kansas criminal code.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
