12 AN ACT concerning retirement and pensions; relating to the Kansas 13 public employees retirement system and systems thereunder; retirant 14 dividend payments; amending K.S.A. 74-49,110 and repealing the ex-15isting section. 16

17Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

18 Section 1. K.S.A. 74-49,110 is hereby amended to read as follows: 19 74-49,110. There is hereby created the retirant dividend payment reserve 20 in the Kansas public employees retirement fund. Prior to October 1, 1980; 21and each October 1 thereafter, the board of trustees of the Kansas public 22 employees retirement system shall credit to the retirant dividend payment reserve an amount equal to the lesser of (1) the amount equal to fifteen 2324percent (15%) of the net amount of interest and dividend income during 25the fiscal year ending on the next preceding June 30 on the investment of the moneys in the fund, adjusted for all realized gains and losses at the 26 27end of such fiscal year or (2) the amount equal to the total of (A) the 28amount required to pay the maximum benefits under K.S.A. 74-49,111, 29 and amendments thereto during the current year and (B) the amount 30 which was required to pay the maximum benefits under K.S.A. 74-49,111 during the preceding year, except that in no case shall the amount cred-31 32 ited under this section result in a carryover balance in the retirant divi-33 dend payment reserve, after payment of all retirant dividend payments that year, of more than an amount equal to the amount which was re-34 35 quired to pay the maximum benefits under K.S.A. 74-49,111 during the 36 preceding year. Such amounts shall be credited from the retirement benefit accumulation reserve. 37 38

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 74-49,110 is hereby repealed.

39 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 40publication in the statute book.
