8 9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas department of agriculture; relating to 10 appointment of secretary thereof; amending K.S.A. 74-560 and re-11 pealing the existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14 Section 1. K.S.A. 74-560 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-15560. (a) On and after the effective date of this act, in order to reorganize 16 the administration, planning and regulation of the state's agriculture in-17dustry there is hereby established within the executive branch of govern-18 ment the Kansas department of agriculture, which shall be administered 19 under the direction and supervision of a secretary of agriculture. 20 The state board of agriculture, established pursuant to K.S.A. 74-21562, shall nominate three individuals to the governor for the appointment 22 as sceretary of agriculture. The governor either shall select and appoint a person nominated to be secretary or shall reject the nominations and 2324request the board to nominate three new individuals for the appointment 25as secretary. Upon receipt of any such request for the nomination of three 26 new individuals, the board shall nominate three new individuals for the 27 appointment as secretary in the same manner The secretary shall be ap-28pointed by the governor. The nominees secretary shall have a demon-29 strated executive and administrative ability to discharge the duties of the 30 office of secretary. Every appointed secretary of agriculture shall be ap-31 pointed subject to confirmation by the senate as provided in K.S.A. 75-32 4315b, and amendments thereto. The secretary shall be a member of the 33 governor's cabinet. The secretary shall serve at the pleasure of the governor. The secretary shall be in the unclassified service under the Kansas 34 35 civil service act and shall receive an annual salary to be fixed by the gov-36 ernor. The acting secretary of agriculture who is serving as the secretary 37 on the effective date of this act shall be the secretary of agriculture as 38 established by this act, shall serve at the pleasure of the governor and 39 shall be subject to confirmation by the senate as provided in K.S.A. 75-404315b, and amendments thereto. Any action of the Senate taken prior to 41 the effective date of this act which confirms an individual as the secretary 42 of agriculture is hereby validated and shall constitute confirmation by the 43 Senate of such individual as secretary of agriculture under this section.

1	(c)	The secretary shall organize a	in annual public informational meet-
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2 ing. The meeting shall take place in each congressional district on a ro-3 tating basis.

4 (d) The provisions of the Kansas governmental operations accounta-

bility law apply to the Kansas department of agriculture, and the department is subject to audit, review and evaluation under such law.
