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8 9 AN ACT concerning the school district finance and quality performance 10 act; relating to certain general state aid payments; amending K.S.A. 11 72-6417 and repealing the existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 72-6417 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-14 156417. (a) The distribution of general state aid under this act shall be made 16 in accordance with appropriation acts each year as provided in this 17section. (b) (1) In the months of July through May of each school year, the 18 19 state board shall determine the amount of general state aid which will be 20 required by each district to maintain operations in each such month. In 21making such determination, the state board shall take into consideration 22 the district's access to local effort sources and the obligations of the gen-23eral fund which must be satisfied during the month. The amount deter-24mined by the state board under this provision is the amount of general 25state aid which will be distributed to the district in the months of July 26 through May; 27 (2) in the month of June of each school year, subject to the provisions 28of subsection (d), payment shall be made of the full amount of the general 29 state aid entitlement determined for the school year, less the sum of the 30 monthly payments made in the months of July through May.

31 (c) Payments of general state aid shall be distributed to districts once 32 each month at a time to be determined by the state board, except as 33 *provided in subsection* (*d*). The state board shall certify to the director of 34 accounts and reports the amount due as general state aid to each district 35 in each of the months of July through June. Such certification, and the 36 amount of general state aid payable from the state general fund, shall be 37 approved by the director of the budget. The director of accounts and 38 reports shall draw warrants on the state treasurer payable to the district 39 treasurer of each district entitled to payment of general state aid, pursuant to vouchers approved by the state board. Upon receipt of such warrant, 40 each district treasurer shall deposit the amount of general state aid in the 41 42 general fund, except that, an amount equal to the amount of federal 43 impact aid not included in the local effort of a district may be disposed

3 (d) On and after the effective date of this act, if any amount of general 4 state aid that is due to be paid during June of a school year pursuant to 5 the other provisions of this section is not paid on or before June 30 of 6 such school year, then such payment shall be paid on or after the ensuing 7 July 1, as soon as moneys are available therefor. Any payment of general 8 state aid that is due to be paid during June of a school year and that is 9 paid by the state of Kansas to districts on or after the ensuing July 1 shall 10 be recorded and accounted for by districts as a receipt for the school year

ending on June 30.
