9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas pet animal act; relating to seizure and10 impoundment of animals.

12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

13 Section 1. (a) When an animal is seized or impounded pursuant to 14 K.S.A. 47-1706, 47-1707 or 47-1715, and amendments thereto, the owner 15or person who was in possession of the animal at the time such animal 16 was seized or impounded shall prevent sale, placement or euthanasia of 17the animal by posting a cash or security bond in an amount sufficient to 18 pay for the animal's care and keeping for a period of at least 30 days, 19commencing on the date which the animal was seized or impounded. Any 20such security bond or any security bond as provided in subsection (b) 21shall be approved by the Kansas animal health department.

22 Such bond shall be filed with the Kansas animal health depart-(b) 23ment and shall be posted on or before the date of the disposition hearing 24or within ten days after the animal is seized or impounded, whichever is 25earlier. At the end of the time for which expenses are covered by the 26 bond if the owner or person who was in possession of the animal at the 27time it was seized or impounded desires to prevent disposition of the 28animal, such owner or person shall post a new cash or security bond prior 29 to the previous bond's expiration. At the end of the time for which ex-30 penses are covered by the bond, the animal may be sold, placed or 31 euthanized.

(c) The authority seizing or impounding an animal shall give notice
by delivering a copy of this section to a person residing on the property
where the animal was seized or by posting a copy at the place where the
animal was seized.

36 (d) Nothing in this section shall prevent the euthanasia at any time
37 of an animal seized or impounded which is determined by a licensed
38 veterinarian to be diseased or disabled beyond recovery for any useful
39 purpose.

40 (e) This act is supplemental to and shall become a part of the Kansas 41 pet animal act.

42 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 43 publication in the statute book.
