8 9 AN ACT concerning the state minimum wage; amending K.S.A. 44-1203 10 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 44-1203 is hereby amended to read as follows: 44-141203. (a) Except as otherwise provided in the minimum wage and maxi-15mum hours law, every employer shall pay to each employee wages at a 16 rate of not less than \$2.65 \$5.15 an hour. In calculating such minimum 17wage rate, an employer may include tips and gratuities received by an 18 employee in an amount equal to not more than 40% of the minimum 19 wage rate if such tips and gratuities have customarily constituted part of 20the remuneration of the employee and if the employee concerned actually 21received and retained such tips and gratuities. The secretary shall require 22 each employer desiring approval of an allowance for gratuities to provide 23 substantial evidence of the amounts of such gratuities on account of which 24the employer has taken an allowance pursuant to this section. 25(b) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any employers 26 and employees who are covered under the provisions of section 6 of the fair labor standards act of 1938 as amended (29 U.S.C.A. § 206), and as 27 amended by the fair labor standards amendments of 1974 and any other 2829 acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto. 30 Sec. 2.
