AN ACT concerning the Kansas healing arts act; concerning use of titles by licensees; amending K.S.A. 65-2885 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 65-2885 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-2885. No person licensed hereunder shall use a title in connection with his such person's name which in any way represents him such person as engaged in the practice of any branch of the healing arts for which he such person holds no license: Provided, however, That every such. Every licensee when using the letters or term "Dr." or "Doctor" shall use the appropriate words or letters to identify himself which identify the licensee with the particular branch of the healing arts in which he the licensee holds a license. Chiropractic licensees may use the title "chiropractic physician."

- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 65-2885 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
