### **SENATE BILL No. 191**

AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to fuel purchases for state motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "motor-vehicle fuels" has the meaning provided by K.S.A. 79-3401, and amendments thereto.

- (b) All bulk motor-vehicle fuels purchased by any state agency, as defined in K.S.A. 75-3701, and amendments thereto, in each fiscal year for use in state-owned motor vehicles shall be motor-vehicle fuels blends containing at least 10% ethanol. No state agency shall spend more than ten five cents per gallon more on fuel blends containing at least 10% ethanol than the current price per gallon of regular fuel on bulk motor vehicle fuel purchases.
- (c) Where available under current state purchasing agreements, individual motor-vehicle fuel purchases for state-owned motor vehicles shall be of motor-vehicle fuels blends containing at least 10% ethanol. Individual motor vehicle fuel purchases for state-owned motor vehicles shall not be more than ten five cents per gallon more on fuel blends containing at least 10% ethanol than the current price per gallon of regular fuel.
- (d) Where available, and as long as the price is no greater than 10 cents more per gallon than the price of diesel fuel; a 2% or higher blend of biodiesel must be purchased for use in *[state-owned]* diesel powered vehicles and equipment.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
