12 AN ACT *concerning capital improvements for state agencies*; mak-
13 ing and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending June 30,
14 2004, and June 30, 2005, for state agencies; authorizing certain trans-
15 fers, capital improvement projects and fees, imposing certain restric-
16 tions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain receipts, dis-
17 bursements and acts incidental to the foregoing; *amending K.S.A.*
18 *2002 Supp. 76-6b05 and repealing the existing section.*

20 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

21 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2004, and June 30,
22 2005, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are
23 hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects, fees, re-
24 cepts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing are hereby di-
25 rected or authorized as provided in this act.

26 (b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate
27 and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized
28 by this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to
29 the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.

32 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following spe-
