12 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; **[concerning distinctive license**
13 **plates;]** providing for the helping schools license plate; **[providing**
14 **for the drive for the cure license plate;]** **[providing for the To-**
15 **peka Lutheran school of Topeka, Kansas, license plate;]** **[pro-**
16 **viding for the masonic lodge license plate;]** amending K.S.A. 8-
17 1,141 and repealing the existing section.

18
19 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

20 New Section 1. (a) Any owner or lessee of one or more passenger
21 vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 20,000 pounds or less,
22 who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with the provisions of this
23 section, may be issued one helping schools license plate for each such
24 passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates shall be issued for the
25 same time as other license plates upon proper registration and payment
26 of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments
27 thereto, and the presentation of the annual logo use authorization state-
28 ment provided for in subsection (b).

29 (b) The state board of education may authorize the use of the logo
30 to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any royalty
31 payment received pursuant to this section shall be remitted to the state
32 treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and
33 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state
34 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit
35 of the helping schools license plate program fund. Any motor vehicle
36 owner or lessee annually may apply to the state board of education for
37 the use of such logo. Upon annual application and payment to the board
38 in an amount of ~~\$50~~ **[\$30]** as a logo use royalty payment for each license
39 plate to be issued, the board shall issue to the motor vehicle owner or
40 lessee, without further charge, a logo use authorization statement, which
41 shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of
42 registration.

43 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may

1 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such per-
2 son's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished by
3 the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plates shall
4 provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in sub-
5 section (b). Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck
6 and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made by the
7 owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon
8 forms furnished by the director. The school district to receive the royalty
9 payment shall be designated by the applicant on such forms.

10 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
11 transferable to any other person.

12 (e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made an-
13 nually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the man-
14 ner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
15 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
16 such applicant provides the annual logo use authorization statement pro-
17 vided for in subsection (b). If such logo use authorization statement is
18 not presented at the time of registration, the applicant shall be required
19 to comply with K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the
20 license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

21 (f) The state board of education shall:

22 ~~—(1) Pay [pay] the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates au-~~
23 ~~thorized by this section; and~~

24 ~~—(2) provide to all county treasurers a toll free telephone number~~
25 ~~where applicants can call the state board of education for information~~
26 ~~concerning the application process or the status of their license plate~~
27 ~~application.~~

28 (g) The state board of education, with the approval of the director of
29 vehicles and subject to the availability of materials and equipment, shall
30 design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this section.

31 New Sec. 2. (a) There is hereby created in the state treasury, the
32 helping schools license plate program fund. All moneys credited to the
33 helping schools license plate fund, except for an amount for reasonable
34 costs to administer the helping schools license plate program provide
35 under section 1, and amendments thereto, shall be allocated and distrib-
36 uted annually on or after July 1 of each year to the school districts des-
37 igned by the applicants under section 1, and amendments thereto. Such
38 money allocated and distributed to the school districts shall be used for
39 the purchase of classroom supplies and equipment in grades K through
40 12 of the public schools of the school district. No moneys shall be dis-
41 tributed under the provisions of this section until the provisions of sub-
42 section (b) of K.S.A. 8-1,141, and amendments thereto, have been satis-
43 fied. All expenditures from the helping schools license plate program fund

1 shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts, upon warrants of
2 the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved
3 by the state board of education or the state board's designee.

4 (b) Moneys allocated and distributed under subsection (a), shall be
5 deemed a donation under K.S.A. 72-8210, and amendments thereto.

6 **[New Sec. 3. (a) On and after January 1, 2004, any owner or**
7 **lessee of one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for**
8 **a gross weight of 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas,**
9 **upon compliance with the provisions of this section, may be issued**
10 **one drive for the cure license plate for each such passenger vehicle**
11 **or truck. Such license plates shall be issued for the same time as**
12 **other license plates upon proper registration and payment of the**
13 **regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments**
14 **thereto, and the presentation of the annual logo use authorization**
15 **statement provided for in subsection (b).**

16 **[(b) The secretary of health and environment may authorize**
17 **the use of the logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by**
18 **this section. Any royalty payment received pursuant to this section**
19 **shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the pro-**
20 **visions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt**
21 **of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire**
22 **amount in the state treasury to the credit of the breast and cervical**
23 **cancer treatment program fund. Any motor vehicle owner or les-**
24 **see annually may apply to the secretary for the use of such logo.**
25 **Upon annual application and payment to the secretary in an**
26 **amount of \$50 as a logo use royalty payment for each license plate**
27 **to be issued, the secretary shall issue to the motor vehicle owner**
28 **or lessee, without further charge, a logo use authorization state-**
29 **ment, which shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner or**
30 **lessee at the time of registration.**

31 **[(c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section**
32 **may make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior**
33 **to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed**
34 **and furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for**
35 **such license plates shall provide the annual logo use authorization**
36 **statement provided for in subsection (b). Application for registra-**
37 **tion of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license**
38 **plate under this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a**
39 **manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms fur-**
40 **nished by the director.**

41 **[(d) No registration or license plate issued under this section**
42 **shall be transferable to any other person.**

43 **[(e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made**

1 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in
2 the manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and
3 amendments thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to
4 any applicant until such applicant provides the annual logo use
5 authorization statement provided for in subsection (b). If such logo
6 use authorization statement is not presented at the time of regis-
7 tration, the applicant shall be required to comply with K.S.A. 8-
8 143, and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the
9 county treasurer of such person's residence.

10 [(f) The secretary of health and environment shall:

11 [(1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates au-
12 thorized by this section; and

13 [(2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone num-
14 ber where applicants can call the secretary of health and environ-
15 ment for information concerning the application process or the
16 status of their license plate application.

17 [(g) The secretary of health and environment, with the ap-
18 proval of the director of vehicles and subject to the availability of
19 materials and equipment, shall design a plate to be issued under
20 the provisions of this section.]

21 [New Sec. 4. (a) On and after January 1, 2004, any owner or
22 lessee of one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for
23 a gross weight of 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas,
24 upon compliance with the provisions of this section, may be issued
25 one Topeka Lutheran school of Topeka, Kansas, license plate for
26 each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates shall be
27 issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper reg-
28 istration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in
29 K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and the presentation of the
30 annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection
31 (b).

32 [(b) The Topeka Lutheran school of Topeka, Kansas, may au-
33 thorize the use of their logo to be affixed on license plates as pro-
34 vided by this section. Any royalty payment received pursuant to
35 this section shall be paid to the Topeka Lutheran school of Topeka,
36 Kansas, and shall be used to support the Topeka Lutheran school
37 of Topeka, Kansas, endowment fund. Any motor vehicle owner or
38 lessee annually may apply to the Topeka Lutheran school of To-
39 peka, Kansas, for the use of such logo. Upon annual application
40 and payment to the Topeka Lutheran school of Topeka, Kansas,
41 in an amount of \$10 as a logo use royalty payment for each license
42 plate to be issued, the Topeka Lutheran school of Topeka, Kansas,
43 shall issue to the motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further

1 charge, a logo use authorization statement, which shall be pre-
2 sented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of
3 registration.

4 [(c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section
5 may make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior
6 to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed
7 and furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for
8 such license plates shall provide the annual logo use authorization
9 statement provided for in subsection (b). Application for registra-
10 tion of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license
11 plate under this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a
12 manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms fur-
13 nished by the director.

14 [(d) No registration or license plate issued under this section
15 shall be transferable to any other person.

16 [(e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
17 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in
18 the manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and
19 amendments thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to
20 any applicant until such applicant provides the annual logo use
21 authorization statement provided for in subsection (b). If such logo
22 use authorization statement is not presented at the time of regis-
23 tration, the applicant shall be required to comply with K.S.A. 8-
24 143, and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the
25 county treasurer of such person's residence.

26 [(f) The Topeka Lutheran school of Topeka, Kansas, shall:

27 [(1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates au-
28 thorized by this section; and

29 [(2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone num-
30 ber where applicants can call the Topeka Lutheran school of To-
31 peka, Kansas, for information concerning the application process
32 or the status of their license plate application.

33 [(g) The Topeka Lutheran school of Topeka, Kansas, with the
34 approval of the director of vehicles and subject to the availability
35 of materials and equipment, shall design a plate to be issued under
36 the provisions of this section.]

37 [New Sec. 5. (a) On and after January 1, 2004, any owner or
38 lessee of one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for
39 a gross weight of 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas,
40 upon compliance with the provisions of this section, may be issued
41 one masonic lodge license plate for each such passenger vehicle
42 or truck. Such license plates shall be issued for the same time as
43 other license plates upon proper registration and payment of the

1 regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments
2 thereto, and the presentation of the annual logo use authorization
3 statement provided for in subsection (b).

4 [(b) The masonic grande lodge of Kansas may authorize the use
5 of their logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this
6 section. Any royalty payment received pursuant to this section shall
7 be paid to the masonic grande lodge of Kansas and shall be used
8 to support the grande lodge of Kansas endowment fund. Any mo-
9 tor vehicle owner or lessee annually may apply to the masonic
10 grande lodge of Kansas for the use of such logo. Upon annual ap-
11 plication and payment to the masonic grande lodge of Kansas in
12 an amount of \$10 as a logo use royalty payment for each license
13 plate to be issued, the masonic grande lodge of Kansas shall issue
14 to the motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a
15 logo use authorization statement, which shall be presented by the
16 motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of registration.

17 [(c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section
18 may make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior
19 to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed
20 and furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for
21 such license plates shall provide the annual logo use authorization
22 statement provided for in subsection (b). Application for registra-
23 tion of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license
24 plate under this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a
25 manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms fur-
26 nished by the director.

27 [(d) No registration or license plate issued under this section
28 shall be transferable to any other person.

29 [(e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
30 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in
31 the manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and
32 amendments thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to
33 any applicant until such applicant provides the annual logo use
34 authorization statement provided for in subsection (b). If such logo
35 use authorization statement is not presented at the time of regis-
36 tration, the applicant shall be required to comply with K.S.A. 8-
37 143, and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the
38 county treasurer of such person's residence.

39 [(f) The masonic grande lodge of Kansas shall:

40 [(1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates au-
41 thorized by this section; and

42 [(2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone num-
43 ber where applicants can call the masonic grande lodge of Kansas

1 **for information concerning the application process or the status of**
2 **their license plate application.**

3 **[(g) The masonic grande lodge of Kansas, with the approval of**
4 **the director of vehicles and subject to the availability of materials**
5 **and equipment, shall design a plate to be issued under the provi-**
6 **sions of this section.]**

7 Sec. ~~6~~ [6.] K.S.A. 8-1,141 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-
8 1,141. (a) Any new distinctive license plate authorized for issuance on and
9 after July 1, 1994, shall be subject to the personalized license plate fee
10 prescribed by subsection (c) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments thereto.
11 This section shall not apply to any distinctive license plate authorized prior
12 to July 1, 1994.

13 (b) The director of vehicles shall not issue any new distinctive license
14 plate authorized for issuance on and after July 1, 1995, unless there is a
15 guarantee of an initial issuance of at least 500 license plates.

16 (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to distinctive license
17 plates issued under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,145, and amendments
18 thereto.

19 (d) The provisions of subsection (a), shall not apply to distinctive li-
20 cense plates issued under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,146 or 8-1,148, and
21 amendments thereto, or ~~K.S.A. 8-1,148 section 1, and amendments~~
22 *thereto.*

23 Sec. ~~4~~ [7.] K.S.A. 8-1,141 is hereby repealed.

24 Sec. ~~5~~ [8.] This act shall take effect and be in force from and after
25 January 1, 2004, and its publication in the statute book.
