SENATE RESOLUTION No. 1842

A RESOLUTION establishing a long-range revenue structure planning group to review tax and revenue structure.

Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Kansas: That a long-range revenue structure planning group be formed, which group shall be composed of 15 members as follows: The president of the senate or a designee of the president; the speaker of the house of representatives or a designee of the speaker; the minority leader of the senate or a designee of the minority leader of the senate; the minority leader of the house of representatives or a designee of the minority leader of the house of representatives; an individual appointed by the governor; the secretary of revenue or the designee of the secretary; the director of the division of budget or a designee of the director; the director of the legislative research department or a designee of the director; the chairperson of the senate committee on ways and means or a designee of the chairperson; the chairperson of the senate committee on assessment and taxation or a designee of the chairperson; the chairperson of the house committee on appropriations or a designee of the chairperson; the chairperson of the house committee on taxation or a designee of the chairperson; and three economists, one appointed by the governor, one appointed by the president of the senate and one appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives. The chairperson and the vice-chairperson of the long-range revenue structure planning group shall be designated by the legislative coordinating council; and

Be it further resolved: That the long-range revenue structure planning group shall meet upon the call of the chairperson of the study group as authorized by the legislative coordinating council; and

Be it further resolved: That the long-range revenue structure planning group shall study the tax and revenue structure of the state and make revenue projections into the future five to 10 years, develop estimates of governmental expenditure projections over such periods of time, review potential revenue adjustment options and study state general fund cash flow requirements. The long-range revenue structure planning group shall develop its findings and recommendations as it deems appropriate and report such findings and recommendations to both houses of the legislature not later than January 12, 2004; and

Be it further resolved: That members of the long-range revenue structure planning group shall receive reimbursement for attending meetings of the long-range revenue structure planning group as may be authorized by the legislative coordinating council consistent with the provisions of K.S.A. 46-1209 and amendments thereto; and

Be it further resolved: That the staff of the legislative research department, the office of the revisor of statutes and the division of legislative administrative services shall provide such assistance as may be requested by the long-range revenue structure planning group.
